

YORK SEWER DISTRICT
Trustee Meeting

Mr. Hoyt, Mr. Knowles, Mr. McIntire (via phone), Mr. Barnett, Mrs Tucker, Mrs Blanchard and Chief Utility Officer Tucker were present at the March 18, 2026, meeting.

Mr. Hoyt called the meeting to order at 3:10 PM.

Mr. McIntire moved and Mr. Knowles seconded to approve the February 11, 2026 minutes. U/A

Mr. McIntire moved and Mr. Knowles seconded to approve the March monthly bills. U/A

Mrs. Blanchard presented the Treasurer's report. Ordinary income is greater than budget and Operating expenses are just under budget through February. Five liens have been released this month.

Mr. Barnett reported that RFP's for the aeration system retrofit have been sent out by Arcadis. A new flow meter has been installed at the 103 pump station to replace the one that was installed in 1991. Currently there has been an increase in flow due to the snowmelt and rain. The inline dynamic mixers have been installed and have cut the polymer usage in half.

The Donica Road project has been pushed back due to weather. CUO Tucker reported that the preconstruction and preblasting pictures should be done next week. Two letters have gone out to property owners and door knockers have been ordered. The District website will have regular updates posted along with District social media accounts. Peter Goodwin has been hired to be the project inspector.

Mrs. Tucker reported that she has completed her annual audit of commercial property discharge volume. 11 notices have been sent to business of impact fees due for the discharge in excess of their permits. Joe Youngs campground on Shore Road has seen significant water usage increase over the past two years so we are working with him to determine the cause and what his permitted discharge should be.

CUO Tucker noted that there have been discussions with the EPA regarding the headworks upgrade and things are starting to move forward free up access to the grant monies.


